

THRIVE – Pray Daily Ross Parsley – January 8, 2017

Thriving means *flourishing* in our humanity as Jesus did in His. *I John 2:6 (NIV)*

As oxygen is to our human life, so prayer is to our spiritual life.

Luke 11:1 (NIV) One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples."

A Pattern for Prayer – *Matthew 9-13 (NIV)*

1. Our Father in heaven – "I am your child and you are near."

Prayer will never be enjoyable until you see God as a loving *Father*.

Matthew 7:11 (NIV) If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

Hallowed be Your name – "You are uniquely respected and loved."

Jesus is giving us a framework for how to *live*.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV) Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; 6 in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

3. Your kingdom come; Your will be done – "What are you doing and how can I cooperate?"

Prayer is more about collaboration than *information*.

James 5:16 (NIV) The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.



1. On earth as it is in heaven – "Give me your perspective and expectation."

Let heaven come to earth through me.

Luke 22:42 (NIV) "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

Give us today our daily bread – "I receive your provision and your timing."

God knows when and He knows how much!

Matthew 4:4 (NIV) Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.""

3. Forgive us our debts as we also have forgiven our debtors – "Help me to love others like you love me."

Forgiveness is a decision, and healing is a *process*.

Matthew 18: 21-22 (NIV) Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?" 22 Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.

4. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one – "You know I am weak, but I know you will save me."

"God, only You have the power we need to defeat the evil one."

1 Corinthians 10:13 (NIV) No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

5. *For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen. — "You are in charge and worthy of all I can give to you." *Some later manuscripts
